It is a law that promotes or seeks to maintain market competition by regulating anti-competitive conduct by companies. The task of implementation of this Act is assigned to Competition Commission of India. There are

many issues and concerns that needs attention and needs to be discussed with proper suggestions of academicians in broad platforms. Word Limit of the Abstract: 300 – 350 words
Abstract shall be accompanied by a brief profile of the author indicating his/ her name, University/Organization/Institution, Email ID, contact number and official address.

Word Limit of the Final Paper: 2500-3000 words.

It must be typed in Times New Roman Font Size 12 on A4 size paper with 1” margin on all sides with 1.5 line spacing using MS Word.
